Directions: Read each question carefully and answer each question with as much detail as possible. Your responses should be typed, labeled, printed out, and submitted upon return to school.

1. Did you like the book? Why or why not? Give an example of something that happens in the book to illustrate your point.
2. Who was your favorite or least favorite character? What was he/she like? Give an example from the book that shows one of his/her traits.
3. What was the setting (time/place)? Was it important to the story? Could this story have happened anywhere and/or anytime?
4. What was a conflict in the story? How was it resolved? What did this show about the character involved?
5. How did the main character in *The Shack* change from beginning to end?
6. What was the author's purpose in writing this book? What message was he trying to tell us?
7. Who would you recommend this book to? Why?
8. Describe the conclusion of the story. Were all the conflicts resolved? Did the story have a satisfying ending? Why or why not?
9. What is the significance of the book's title, *The Shack*?
10. Choose 2 quotes from *The Shack* that stood out to you. Explain what they mean and what the quotes importance/significance is to the story as a whole.
